## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1. RULES.**

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 ISAF *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.3 Part 5, Section B of *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, as well as rules 44.1 and 63.1 will be changed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 All boats are required to carry a working VHF radio ready for use.

### **2. ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising will conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The Cruiser Race series are open to boats owned by or chartered to any CYC member or visiting yachtsmen who are members of an RYA affiliated Yacht or Sailing Club. Skippers and Crew who are not CYC members are permitted to race but the use of the club's facilities shall be strictly in accordance with the conditions set out in CYC club rule 3.1.3. Any trophy which is subject to a requirement that it should only be awarded to a member of CYC cannot be awarded to a non-member.
- 3.2 Competitors must have completed a CYC Race entry form and signed the declaration. For Regattas this procedure may be completed while afloat and handed to a CYC Safety Boat.

### **4. CLASSIFICATION AND CREW**

- 4.1 There are no ISAF Sailor Classification Code requirements.

### **5. FEES**

- 5.1 There shall be no entry fees unless specified for certain events.

### **6. SCHEDULE**

- 6.1 The Schedule shall be as published in the CYC Sailing Programme as amended from time to time by email to registered skippers, the CYC website and on the CYC Notice Board.

### **7. MEASUREMENT and EQUIPMENT INSPECTION**

- 7.1 The Organisers may measure or inspect any boat and or her equipment and sails before, during or after the races to ensure conformity with CYC Sailing Instructions.

### **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 8.1 The current CYC Sailing Instructions must be complied with. These are published on the CYC website and are available in the Clubhouse.
